
About New Member Welcome Center



What Is An International Workshop?

- Annual event, typically held at end of January at a rotating location, for systems engineers to contribute to the state of the art
 - Working sessions and business meetings
 - Working group meetings focused on improving and completing working group products, standards development, systems engineering challenges.
 - Business meetings for strategic, operational and leadership focused topics
 - Outreach sessions focused on disseminating the current state of the art to Workshop attendees with no of little previous exposure to the working groups
- Unlike the International Symposium where theme-related paper, panels, tutorial or presentations occur, IW attendees spend 3 focused days working alongside fellow systems
- IW is open to members and non-members


